# How To Get There

## October Monthly Party • 7:30 PM

Mountain View Masonic Lodge, 890 Church Street, Mountain View, CA 94041

DIRECTIONS: From 280: exit at S. El Monte Avenue, to Foothill Expressway. Right on Foothill Expressway, left on Miramonte Avenue, across El Camino Real W., to S. Shoreline Blvd. Turn right onto Church Street. From 101 North: Exit at Moffett Blvd. Follow Moffett Blvd. south to Central Expressway. Cross Central Expressway on to Castro Street. Turn right onto Church Street (5 blocks). From 101 South: Exit at North Shoreline Boulevard and turn right. Follow North Shoreline; turn left onto Church Street.

Park in the small lot behind the building, accessed from Franklin Street, or on neighborhood streets.

## November Monthly Party • 7:30 PM—*Note: second Saturday!*

Arlington Community Church, 52 Arlington Avenue, Kensington, CA 94707

DIRECTIONS: From Highway 80, exit on Buchanan Street, head towards the hills. Buchanan turns into Marin Avenue. Take Marin to “The Circle”, go about  $\frac{3}{4}$  around (270°) to exit onto Arlington Avenue. The church is 1.9 miles up the hill, on the left. Cross street is Rincon Road. Alternatively, take Moeser Lane up from San Pablo Ave. in El Cerrito to turn right onto Arlington Ave. There is a parking lot across the street from the church.

## December Monthly Party • 3:00 PM—*Note: afternoon start time!*

Hill and Valley Club, 1808 B Street, Hayward, CA 94541

DIRECTIONS: From the West (via 580 East), exit at Grove Way. Turn right on Grove Way, then first left onto Center Street. Center Street bears right and becomes B Street. The hall will be on your right. Cross street is Linden Street. From the West (via the San Mateo Bridge): Take CA-92 East. Continue onto Foothill Blvd. (also named Jackson Street). Turn right onto B Street. The hall will be on your left. From the East: (via 580 West), exit at Castro Valley. Turn left onto Castro Valley Blvd., then left on Grove Way, then left onto Center Street. Center Street bears right and becomes B Street. The hall will be on the right. Park on Linden Street or in the small parking lot behind the Club.
